## Sacred Heart Catholic Church DMI Survey – Interim Update



Earlier this year, the parishioners of Sacred Heart were asked to participate in a parish-wide survey, also referred to as the Disciple

Maker Index. The survey gave people an opportunity to reflect on their spiritual growth, level of involvement in the parish, as well as their satisfaction with the parish and parish related activities. Approximately 42% of our active parishioners completed the survey. Thank you for taking time to share your thoughts. As a result of your efforts, the parish has gained valuable insight into your needs and how we can enhance our faith based community so we can grow as disciples of Jesus.




Figure 1: Parish strength survey results




Figure 2: Parish opportunities for growth survey results
